

Use of photographs

Directives I have written down here govern the use of any of my photographs.

- All photographs are copyrighted and protected by law, and anyone wishing to use said photo (s) must get written permission from said photographer, Pete Vertefeuille, in order to use them.
- I retain complete control (retaining all rights) of usage of every image I've created.
- Anyone wishing to use any of my photos may do so for a single purpose, one time usage, agreed upon by myself and the person wishing to use my photography. That person wishing to use my photo (s) may not use those photos for any other purpose without further permission from said photographer, other than the original purpose intended.
- No hard copies may be printed, shared or stored by any means, for any purpose other than what is written on the original contract.
- There may or may not be a fee charged for using any of my images depending what is involved: if I have to use any material or supplies to complete an order, if I am asked to do an assignment, time and materials are to be considered in the fee, if there is a small amount of images sent to the client by electronic means, there may be no fee assigned.
- I may also request to have acknowledgement for the use of my photography.
