The regular meeting of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Commission was held on **Monday, April 9, 2007** at the Town Office Building.

Item 8: Discuss and act on any other business

8.1 Dan Rioux commented on the enforcement issue that had been discussed in February regarding the property on East Old Route 6 (Sears); also issue on Bigelow Road/Route 6 where there seems to be some activity and the backhoe is stuck in the wetland area; also questioning the excavation/silt fence on 89 North Bigelow Road. The first two issues will be looked into further. The excavation/silt fence on 89 North Bigelow Road, Marty Mlyniec reported that it looked fine in the back.

8.2 Budget - It was decided by the Commission to discuss this after reviewing the regulations as a discussion regarding fees will be discussed.

8.3 Regulations

Motion: Marty Mlyniec made a motion to change the word “agency” to “commission” including the definition. The motion was seconded by Phoebe Huang. The motion carried by unanimous consent.

Motion: Phoebe made a motion to change “inclusive” when referring to CGS (Connecticut General Statutes) to “through.” The motion was seconded by Kevin Harrington. The motion carried by unanimous consent.

Dan Rioux commented about the wetland upland review area and that it could be changed based on certain areas that may need different boundaries. This is something that should be thought about and ideas should be brought out.

Motion: Phoebe Huang made a motion to change the application to state that the completed application should be dropped off at the Town Hall to the Town Clerk and that Harold’s name and phone number should be deleted. The motion was seconded by Dan Rioux. The motion carried by unanimous consent.

Motion: Dan Rioux made a motion to change the fee schedule as attached. The motion was seconded by Marty Mlyniec. The motion carried by unanimous consent.

Motion: Marty Mlyniec made a motion to request \$5,000 for the budget for 2007-2008. The motion was seconded by Dan Rioux. The motion carried by unanimous consent.
