BOAA Hearing

- II. John Berard made a motion to take no action for PLH Vineyard Sky LLC's appeal (solar company on Fisk Rd). The appellant did not appear at the meeting. Aaron Tumel seconded the motion. All voted in favor to take no action and the appeal was denied.
- III. John Berard made a motion to take no action for Trent Hagerty's appeal for relief on supplemental motor vehicle tax. The appellant did not appear at the meeting. Aaron Tumel seconded the motion. All voted in favor to take no action and the appeal by Mr. Hagerty was denied.
- IV. The BOAA heard an appeal in person by Mahlon Stoltzfus of Fresh Vision Hardscapes LLC for a business he claimed did not own equipment as he subcontracted out the minimal work his business had. The committee advised Mr. Stoltzfus to fill out a declaration of personal property form for some equipment owned by his business (computer, office equipment, etc). John Berard made a motion to accept a personal property declaration form from Fresh Vision Hardscapes LLC, and to deny their initial appeal. Aaron Tumel seconded the motion. All voted in favor to accept the personal property declaration and to deny the initial appeal.
