Hampton and Scotland School Readiness Council Policies for Programs Receiving School Readiness Funds

O. Transition to Kindergarten

1. All school readiness programs must have a plan and procedure in place to ensure that children and their families experience a smooth and successful transition through the following best practices:
 - a. provide program continuity through developmentally appropriate curricula;
 - b. promote and maintain ongoing communication and collaboration with the public school, most particularly with kindergarten program personnel;
 - c. prepare and support children in the transition to kindergarten; and
 - d. prepare and involve families in a partnership with the public school to support the transition to kindergarten.
2. All school readiness programs must provide for the transfer of records and other relevant information (with appropriate permission) to the kindergarten program in a timely manner prior to the child's entry to school.
