## O. Transition to Kindergarten

- 1. All school readiness programs must have a plan and procedure in place to ensure that children and their families experience a smooth and successful transition through the following best practices:
  - a. provide program continuity through developmentally appropriate curricula;
  - b. promote and maintain ongoing communication and collaboration with the public school, most particularly with kindergarten program personnel;
  - c. prepare and support children in the transition to kindergarten; and
  - d. prepare and involve families in a partnership with the public school to support the transition to kindergarten.
- 2. All school readiness programs must provide for the transfer of records and other relevant information (with appropriate permission) to the kindergarten program in a timely manner prior to the child's entry to school.
