Annual Town Meeting

The legal voters and those qualified to vote in Town Meeting are hereby warned to assemble in Town Meeting at the Hampton Elementary School, 380 Main Street in Hampton, Connecticut on **Monday, May 16, 2011 at 7:30 p.m.** to transact the following business:

Items 8 and 9 will adjourn to referendum vote to be held on Tuesday, May 17, 2011 from Noon to 8:00 p.m.

1. Call to order.
2. To elect a moderator for said meeting.
3. To authorize the Board of Selectmen to borrow, if necessary, money to defray expenses until other funds are available.
4. To nominate and elect one member to the Regional District 11 Board of Education for a term of three years beginning with their first Board meeting in July, 2011.
5. To authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into agreement with the Commissioner of Connecticut Department of Transportation for the expenditure of funds available July 1, 2011 for the fiscal year July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012 for improvement and maintenance of Town roads.
6. To authorize the Board of Selectmen to approve and accept Local Capital Improvement Funds (LoCIP) from the State of Connecticut for road improvement.
7. To approve the *5 Year Capital Improvement Plan* including the *5 Year Road Plan*.
8. To hear discussion on the General Government Budget for FY July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012 as submitted by the Board of Selectmen, and to appropriate sums of money as required.
9. To hear discussion on the Hampton Elementary School Education Budget for FY July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012 as submitted by the Board of Education, and to appropriate sums of money as required.
10. To consider and act upon a proposed ordinance entitled "Waiver of Property Tax" pursuant to the provisions of Section 12-144c of the General Statutes of Connecticut . A copy of the proposed ordinance is on file in the Town Clerk's Office and may be reviewed during regular business hours.
11. To consider and act upon a proposed ordinance entitled "Payment of Delinquent Motor Vehicle Taxes" pursuant to the provisions of Section 12-146 of the General Statutes of Connecticut. A copy of the proposed ordinance is on file in the Town Clerk's Office and may be reviewed during regular business hours.
12. To consider and act upon a proposed ordinance entitled "Right to Farm Ordinance" pursuant to the provisions of Section 1-1(q) & 19a-3411 of the General Statutes of Connecticut. A copy of the proposed ordinance is on file in the Town Clerk's Office and may be reviewed during regular business hours.

13. To consider and act upon a proposed ordinance entitled “An Ordinance Establishing Hampton Agriculture Commission” pursuant to the provisions of Section 1-1(q) of the General Statutes of Connecticut. A copy of the proposed ordinance is on file in the Town Clerk’s Office and may be reviewed during regular business hours.
14. To transact any other business proper to come before the meeting.

Adjournment.

At its meeting held on May 2, 2011, the Board of Selectmen voted, pursuant to Section 7-7 of the Connecticut General Statutes, that items 8 and 9 on the call of the May 16, 2011 Town Meeting be submitted to referendum vote on May 17, 2011, between the hours of Noon and 8:00p.m. at the Town Hall, 164 Main Street, Hampton, CT.

The designation of the questions on the ballot for said referendum vote shall be as follows:

1. “Shall the Town of Hampton appropriate **\$1,728,330** for the General Government for the 2011-2012 fiscal year?”
2. “Shall the Town of Hampton appropriate **\$2,256,188** for the Hampton Elementary School for 2011-2012 fiscal year?”
