Building Inspections - COVID-19 Update

Until further notice, due to concern for the COVID-19 protocols, the Assessor's Office is making changes to how data collection and field work is performed (as part of the real estate appraisals for properties that have changed/been improved since 2019). The Assessor will be continuing "Exterior Only" Building Permit inspections in order to update town assessment data as may be necessary. These inspections will focus on permits for items such as: Decks, sheds, porches, garages, swimming pools, central air conditioning, roofs, siding, and additions etc. While onsite for these type of inspections, confirm existing information is also confirmed and often exterior measurements are checked for quality control purposes.

While I prefer appointments, exterior only inspections may be made without notice or appointments because they are grouped by neighborhoods in order to make the most efficient use of town resources. The Assessor's vehicle is a black Subaru Crosstrek XV.

For your own safety as well as our employees, ANY face to face conversation should be with a distance of no less than six feet while wearing a face mask. If it is more convenience, you may call the office -the Assessor will be happy to answer any questions you may have.
