# TUESDAY, MAY 13, 2025 7:00 PM HAMPTON BOARD OF EDUCATION SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

#### 1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:01. Those in attendance were Mark Becker, Stephanie Bora, Maryellen Donnelly, Elizabeth Lindorff, David Halbach and Dennis Timberman. Also in attendance was Superintendent Andrew Skarzynski.

- 2. Audience Citizens and Public on Agenda Items Only
  Tim Studer commented on the budget regarding paraprofessionals.
- 3. Discussion and Possible Action: 2025/2026 Budget

The \$2,376,227 budget passed by the Board on March 26 detailed an increase of 9.02% which is \$196,627 over the current 2024-2025 budget. The board was provided a table of budget amounts, dollar increases over the 2024-2025 budget and dollars needed to be reduced from the March 26 budget to yield from 8% to 1% increases over the 2024-2025 budget. The board reviewed *Hampton Budget Discussion 5/13/25* detailing the time necessary to provide tiered support sessions; the HES budget increase from 2011-2025 and the Social Security COLA with averages of -0.15143 for HES budgets and 2.628571 for SS; cost drivers and savings; previous cuts; and, new \$25,000 savings in special education. The board discussed object functions and requested that Superintendent Skarzynski identify savings in objects they identified. Action was not taken.

### 4. Audience for Citizens and Public

Allan Cahill asked about funding for substance abuse and drug education. Kathy Donahue commented on reserve funds. Christian Macias-Perez commented on the budget.

# 5. Adjournment

**Motion**: Maryellen Donnelly moved to adjourn. Stephanie Bora seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 7:59 PM. The motion passed unanimously.
