The special meeting of the Hampton Board of Selectmen was called to order at 1:01 PM by First Selectman Allan Cahill. Members present were Selectman Bob Grindle and Selectman John Tillinghast. Also present were members of the public, and Administrative Assistant Jennifer Nelson.

John Tillinghast seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.**
- **5**. The Board of Finance met the previous evening, and the proposed actions were finalized for the public hearing which will be held on May 25<sup>th</sup>. The town meeting will follow on June 8<sup>th</sup>, and a referendum will be held on June 15<sup>th</sup> for 6 questions. **Bob Grindle moved to accept the items for the call of the meeting, as written. Allan Cahill seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.**
- **6.** The board and public discussed the various upgrades to public lands in Hampton.

Bob Grindle moved to adjourn at 1:18 PM. John Tillinghast seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
