Selectman Grindle was at transfer station and sold approximately 150 stickers. Will be there again on October 26 and November 2. Sent Selectman Meade to FEMA meeting. Stone Hurst is building apartments for the guest at functions at Stonehurst. The land on West Frisk Road has been cleared for solar farm. Research is ongoing for the pavilion. Ben Brocket sent letter that the ambulance will cease April 1, 2020. Ambulance source is on going. The Town Aid Road and Local Capital Improvement Program money has not been awarded yet by Connecticut.

Penny Newbury questioned if Fire Department could get certified and transport. We do not have enough volunteers. It is a different level of service. We are not set up for it. Will be working on getting the certification.

The Community Opportunity Group Services since 1993 Ct, the 2016 grant is done. After 25 years the grant will no longer be available to us. We have program money to finish projects started now and administration.

Motion: Selectman Grindle/First Selectman Cahill moved/seconded to approve the Special Town Meeting to Purchase Tree Truck. Date October 24 at 6:30 downstairs. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously.
