5. Old Business
  - a. Composting campaign grant- flyers, timeline  
The RecycleCT Foundation grant was awarded in the amount of \$4750 with one half to be received shortly and the other at the completion of the final report. The project needs to be completed by November 30, 2022 and the final report sent by December 31 2022. Kate will work on a general brochure, Maryellen will contact the schools to investigate working together, and if composting is being done in the schools, Jon will investigate purchasing composting bins, and Roger will investigate storage of bins until distribution. Kate will notify town officials about the grant. The committee anticipates a town wide mailing in early March to determine those interested in compost bins, purchasing amount needed and distribution in late April. Data will be kept on success of program for the final report.
  - b. Updates- HES, Solar Production, Killingly
