- 1. Called to Order Chairman Kevin Grindle called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm.
- 2. Roll Call/Seating of Alternate Members In attendance were PZC members Everett Hyde, Gary DeCesare, Stanley Crawford and Susan Hochstetter. Also in attendance were Alternate Kathy Thompson, Selectmen Allan Cahill and Bob Grindle, and Town Planner John Guszkowski.

  - a. Discussion and Consideration of Stipulation in Settlement of Zoning Appeal Commercial Campground on Old Town Pound Road John Guszkowski reviewed the settlement agreement with the Commission. Appeal Plaintiff James Krall addressed the Commission concerning the first condition of the settlement concerning the five-hundred-foot setback. - 7. Affordable Housing Sub-Committee

The Commission had a detailed discussion about what multifamily means and looks like in Hampton. John Guszkowski spoke to the Commission on the parameters of multifamily regulations and what are the next steps are. The Commission will continue this discussion at the next meeting.
