Mark Becker presented estimates for paving three designated areas and fixing catchment basins. Allan Cahill discussed the need for a generator. Committee Chair Becker will attend the April 16 Board of Finance meeting to discuss costs and funding. An upright freezer was purchased to replace the chest freezer in the kitchen. Principal Roberson will provide the committee with the essays from a persuasive writing prompt about playgrounds. The Fire Marshall will visit the school on March 28 to assess the need for a new fire panel and to review where students and staff congregate during a drill.

- Discussion of 2019/2020 Budget The 2018/2019 budget did not meet Hampton's Minimum Budget Requirement by \$2,122. The committee will recommend to the Board of Eduction that this amount be added to the 2019/2020 budget to remain at 0% increase.
