a. Lock down in music room, lunch, gym classes and the locations were reviewed by the Trooper Carrao (Brooklyn Resident Trooper)

- b. Should people not students be removed from the basketball courts during school yes
- c. Vendors sign to use front entrance and sign in to be placed on cafeteria back door
- d. Fire drill questions and the use of buses for any winter or inclement weather

conditions - how to keep students safe crossing to buses

- e. No door wedges can be used
- f. Cover glass in classroom doors for lock down

g. No notice should be given for any drill - some issues need to be discussed for a special ed. student

h. All staff need to have name tags on at all times (LifeTouch)

- i. Pre-K might need to practice but need to be aware of the drill that will be coming up
- 5. Review any new research
 - a. The issue of stay in place or flee was discussed and will need more follow-up
- 6. Review other departments or individuals who need to be included in the safety/emergency plan
 - a. Bus company and location of drivers and the bus keys
 - b. Any CDL licensed people on staff?
 - c. DPW for Town of Hampton road blockage / traffic control
- 7. Develop calendar for next meeting
 - a. To be determined
- 8a. Develop framework for revised plan
 - a. Research how to effectively handle / train very young children for emergencies
 - b. Student / Teacher use of cell phones during emergency
 - c. Entrance pad to announce people at times does not work properly

d. Each person needs to be buzzed in and do not allow parents to let others into school if

- they are standing in the hallway waiting for their child
 - e. Key idea is to stall person for as long as possible
 - f. Security window in office needs to be "hardened" tinted glass / bar installed
 - g. School keys should be given to Troop D for emergency entrance
 - h. Fire Department does it have building keys?
 - i. Winter drill use DPW / buses for shelter
 - j. J&S for modern walkie-talkies purchases
 - k. Drills for recess return to building or flee?
- 8.b Develop written plan for HES
 - a. To be accomplished by end of 2018 and then reviewed
 - b. Smaller intermediate steps to be completed ASAP
 - c. Research impact on young children of lock down activities
 - d. All HES staff to be informed of these plans as they are implemented
