Upon the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of a public agency present and voting, any subsequent business not included in such filed agendas may be considered and acted upon at such meetings [Freedom Of Information Act Sec. 1-225, (c)]. The date of receipt of a petition, application, request or appeal shall be the day of the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Agency, immediately following the day of submission to the Agency or its agent of such petition, application, request or appeal or thirty-five (35) days after such submission, whichever is sooner [Town Of Hampton, Connecticut Inland Wetlands And Watercourses Regulations Sec. 8, 8.4].
