New Business

Item 1: WP0919-01: Stonehurst at Hampton Valley, LLC; 119 Providence Tpke, Hampton, Ct. Proposed Activity: Applicant proposes to relocate an existing man-made drainage ditch to construct 20 paved parking spaces that will be utilized for proposed guest rooms. The new swale will be over excavated and 6” of sandy material will be placed and compacted. Topsoil/organics from the existing ditch will be placed on top of the sand, seed will be applied, and the seed will be topped with jute netting to allow for vegetation to be established.

Normand Thibeault, representing the applicant, reviewed the map and the site of the proposed activity and answered questions regarding the drainage ditch and the parking spaces. Mr. Thibeault also brought members on a tour of the property, specifically the location of a proposed new facility and its septic system, which has been approved by the health department, the approximate location of a proposed chapel and a mechanical building, and drainage swales and basins currently in use. (Alternates Diane Gagnon and Pat Cascio did not participate in the tour of the property.)
