- Accurate housing demographics that include accessory apartments and new construction single-family dwellings
- Real estate climate (harder to sell houses)
- Comparison to local towns (including Brooklyn)

The Commission decided to invite local realtor Angelika Hansen to attend an upcoming meeting to share some insight for this section.
