Currently there are few events scheduled at the school. In October there will be a bus drill and a social distance picture day. Staff members are collecting data and information on ways to improve student instruction, movement and emotional wellbeing. Communication with families has been and will continue to be a regular and documented activity. Distance learning plans are strengthen with each opportunity that classroom teachers and SRBI/media staff are able to meet to organize remote learning. We currently have 17 students doing remote learning. Social Emotional Learning as well as individual support for families and students has been critical in working towards a more successful transition. Teachers are instructing students on what to do during a lock down and our first fire will be done within the guidelines of social distancing. Staff members are using zoom to communicate between each other and within groups. Any changes or unexpected concerns and successes are shared with either Mrs. Danielson or Administration.
