Google Classroom

All teachers used Google Classroom throughout the COVID closing. Lower grade teachers were engaged in learning how to navigate this Google tool through collaborating with other teachers, PD with EASTCONN and a little bit of trial and error. It is designed to support in person classes and other LMS and has been used by upper grades as a tool that integrates with the entire learning and teaching experience. It's free to use easy to navigate and our teachers can post assignments, videos, quizzes and slide shows or power points. The Google classroom works well for sharing material, encouraging online discussions and offering lessons and quizzes when students can't be in the traditional classroom. Students can post comments if teachers allow, teachers can make updates and can invite other staff members to co-teach with them. This turned out to be a plus for para professionals to be able to support a Google Meet or to check on or encourage students to complete work. In addition, teachers are able to send out mass information to all parents. As administrator I can join any Google classroom to check lesson plans, assignments and join in on a meet in session as a participant or observer. When we end up back in the building for the 2020- 2021 school year, Google Classroom will be a tool that all educators can continue to use. I have received several emails from parents and para-professionals about the benefits of being to use this app and pleasure in discovering how user friendly it has been.

Our school has many considerations as we plan our return to school. We must balance the need for equity and provide an environment that is safe on many levels, emotionally, educationally and healthy.

Staff members have been meeting to trouble shoot as well as engaging families in ways that have been fun and interactive. We have received many pictures and staff have made several classic videos to share on our web page. We have been researching technology tools and equipment that is best suited for all variables.

Field Day

On June 9th Mrs. Garrison held a virtual field day. The PTO donated t-shirts, which parents picked up here at school. Eleven events were given and several if not all were achieved by those that were able to participate. Students documented their achievement and sent picture back here to school where Mrs. Sorel, Mrs. Conti and Ms. Garrison created a "hopping" video to share.
