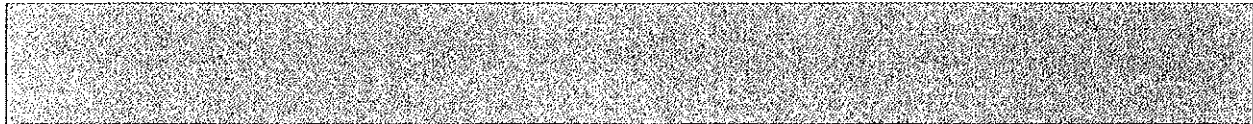


Hampton Elementary School

Principal Report
May 15, 2020



- High percentage of students using Success Maker. Two – five times a week
- Google Classroom student lessons posted daily Upper grades work with classroom teachers AM, lower grades post lesson daily
- All classroom teachers hold office hours daily
- All teams review and report problems, concerns or lack of contact from families
- Packets for learning are sent home at regularly scheduled times
- Modified services are reviewed and provided to all students that require support
- Website is updated weekly or as needed
- Specials teachers continue to post weekly assignments with instructions for documenting work
- Staff meetings and team meeting continue daily (team) and or weekly (staff)
- EASTCONN PD- Staff consult as needed for technology or collaboration
- Para professionals completing Masters Teachers PD and supporting students/staff through making packets, attending classroom meets, planning interventions with teachers

In the Building Procedures and Schedule

All teachers are in the building on a rotating schedule. Time blocks are posted and all guidelines as outlined by Dr. Olah are enforced. All student/family pick-ups for material are outside in front of the building. When in the building teachers and paras are preparing materials to send home or preparing their classrooms for summer cleaning per the announcement on May 5th that schools would not be reopening this school year.

On May 15 the SRBI team supported by other staff members organized a “Wave BY”. Staff members decorated their cars, played upbeat music, and practiced social distancing and wearing mask. 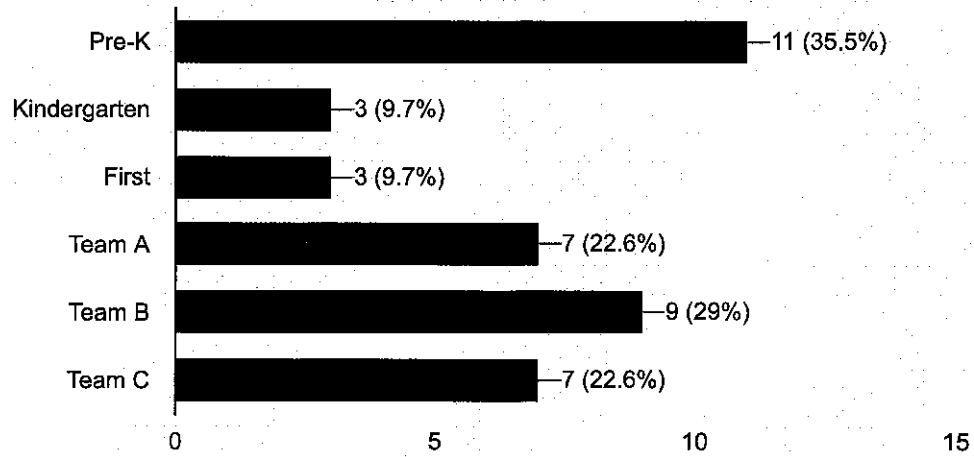

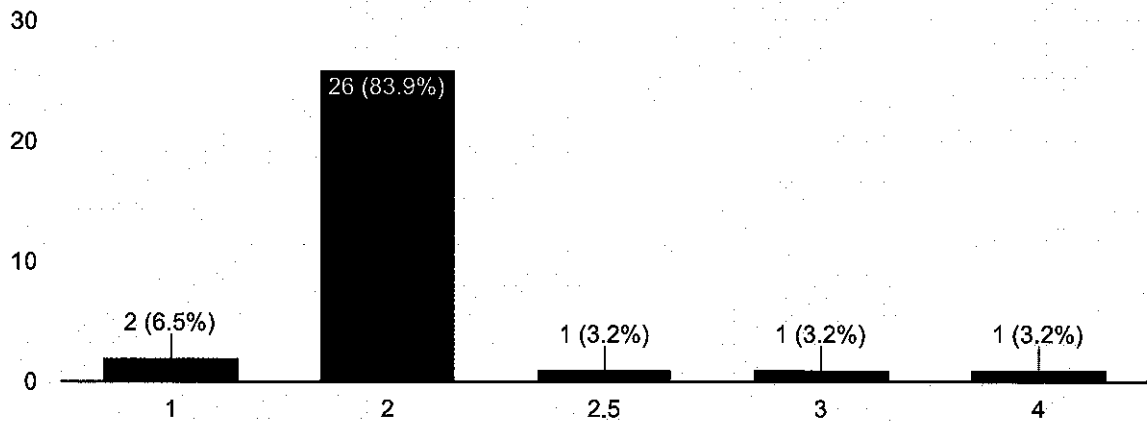
Which grade/team is your child in? Check all apply.

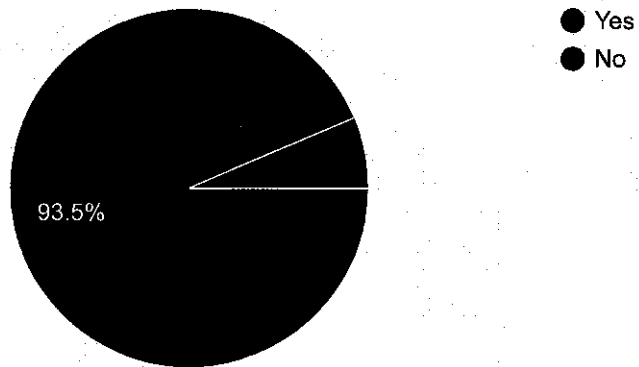
The number of adults in your household...

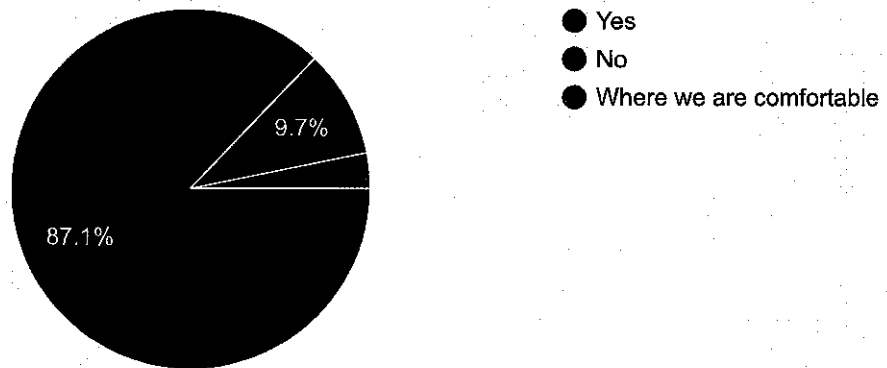

Great we work from 9-5 and school work is done from 9-3:30.

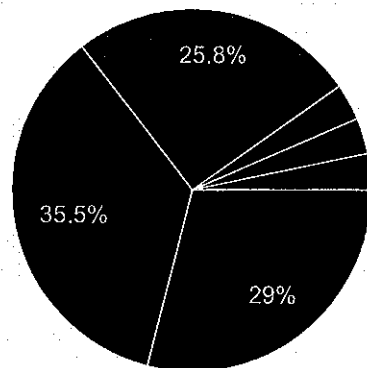
It works...

I would describe my child's participation in Continuity of Learning opportunities as

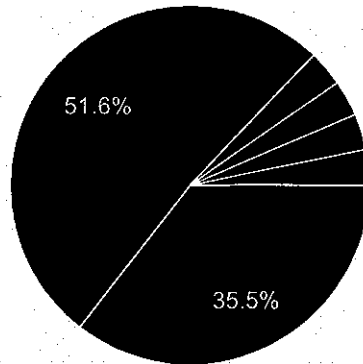

Ease of access to online materials is

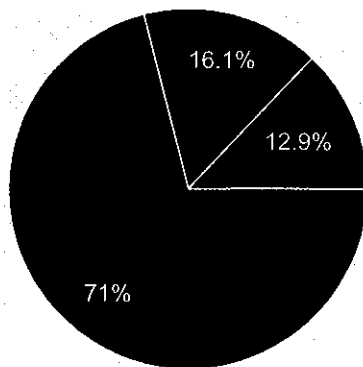
