Thursday December 30, 2010 will be the last day of business for the Hampton Probate Court, established in 1837.

As of the official date of January 5, 2011, all of Hampton's probate matters, both new cases, and those already in progress, will be handled by the newly established Windham-Colchester Probate Court, Hon. John McGrath, presiding. That court will be located at 979 Main Street, Willimantic (the old Willimantic Town Hall building at the corner of High Street.) The mailing address is P.O. Box 34, Willimantic, CT 06226. The Phone Number is 860-465-3049, and the fax number is 860-2162. After December 30, please direct all inquiries to the new court.

Probate matters include wills and estates, trusts, guardianships of minors and the mentally disabled, adoptions, termination of parental rights, other children's matters, and conservatorships for adults who cannot handle their own affairs.

For the time being the bound records of the Hampton Probate Court will remain in the Hampton Town Hall vault, under the supervision of the Town Clerk.

It has been our honor to serve the people of Hampton and the Hampton Probate Court since November of 2001. We sincerely regret the inconvenience that this will cause the people of Hampton.
