

### Math Class with Ms. Sanchini and Mr. Lord September 17, 2021


### Our math class will... look like

Students in our class will learn to flexibly work with numbers.

Reading- We will be starting our first unit on getting to know characters in books we are reading. We have been learning about what it means to be a good reader.


Math- We are starting our first unit on adding within 20. We will will be learning about new strategies such as counting on and using a numberline to help with counting.

### Math with Ms. Sanchini September 2021

Hello,

Your child has been placed with me for math class for the domain: Operations and Algebraic Thinking. Our class meets daily from 11:10 - 12:10 in the Team B classroom for 8 - 10 weeks.

Safety protocols will continue to be maintained in each classroom. This means 3 feet apart, facing forward, masks indoors, upon entry to the room the students will use hand sanitizer as well as I will maintain cleaning of room areas and materials.

Here is information about HES's personalized learning program that I put together to share with you.

Our school is continuing to develop our mission to provide personalized learning opportunities for our students. Math is the area that we are continuing to explore. This means that our students will be combined by similar math objectives and by doing this some students will be moved to other classroom spaces. Mr. Gervase and Mr. Shifrin will also be classroom math teachers. For each of the four math domains, groups will be reviewed and changes for placement may be made.

Here is a bit about our process towards personalized learning. Personalized learning always involves these core four elements - targeted instruction, data-driven decisions, flexible content, and student reflection and ownership.

- ★ Targeted instruction: Teachers will create personalized instruction using our school wide programs, EnVision Math and iReady Math.
- ★ Data driven decisions: To begin to form math classes, the students took part in the iReady math diagnostic. The diagnostic follows the common core standards and from this we chose to begin with the math domain; operations and algebraic thinking. Other considerations from classroom teachers were weighed and classes were formed.
- ★ Flexible Content: This means to provide direct teaching, extra practice, remediation and extension activities that pace students to grow with the math content. In math, we will be organized by the 4 domains and will update the class groupings throughout the year.
- ★ Student Reflection and Ownership: Students make goals and I Can statements.

One last thing, this is a new process for us and so communication is really important for success. I post on my class webpage, and have created a math google classroom. I will send email and will send home news and updates in the Home and Back folders or student planners. Another handout is attached with our operations and algebraic math thinking classroom information.
