When is My Payment Considered Late?

Bills are due August 1, 2023, and must be received, or postmarked, no later than September 1, 2023.

Payments due January 1, 2024, must be received, or postmarked, no later than February 1, 2024.

For late payments, interest is charged at a rate of 1.5% per month from the due date, with a minimum interest charge of \$2.00.

Per State Statute, interest cannot be waived.

What am I being Taxed on?

You are being taxed on Real Estate, Personal Property and Motor Vehicles appearing on the Town's Grand List as of **October 1, 2022.**

How can I Pay?

There are three coupons on the original bill – one for July, one for January and one for your records. You can pay in full in July if you choose. You can pay via mail, online or drop payment in the drop box outside the front door of Windham Town Hall.

What if I no longer own this vehicle?

If you no longer own a vehicle you are being billed for during the period indicated on the front page, please contact the Assessor's Office for discussion at (860) 455-9132 ext. 5.

Where did you get this address for my motor vehicle bill?

The address on your motor vehicle bill is from the Department of Motor Vehicles. If the address is incorrect, please notify us and DMV. You will need to update your vehicle's registration address.

What if I paid off my mortgage?

If you pay off your mortgage – congratulations! But please notify our office for the mortgage company may not inform our office in a timely manner.
