

Hampton Board of Selectmen
Special Meeting Minutes
Hampton Town Hall
March 19, 2026

The Special Meeting of the Hampton Board of Selectmen was called to order at 6:32 PM by First Selectman Allan Cahill. Also present were Selectmen Bob Grindle and John Tillinghast, and Jennifer Nelson, Administrative Assistant.

Audience for Citizens: None

2. Interlocal Tax Agreement: Tax payments are currently collected by Windham, but the collector resigned, and the office has been reorganized. Tax collection documentation has not been received since December 2025, and NECCOG submitted a Regional Performance Incentive Program (RPIP) Grant application on behalf of Canterbury, Scotland, and Hampton to provide tax collection services for all three towns. The selectmen discussed the difficulty Hampton has experienced, the need to provide accurate tax services for the residents of Hampton, and cost of such a change. First Selectman Cahill recommended a Special Town Meeting before the next selectmen's meeting on April 6th at 6:30 PM to present the agreement to the residents of Hampton, as outlined in the resolution to provide tax services. **Selectman Bob Grindle moved to pursue the Interlocal Tax Agreement. Selectman John Tillinghast seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.**

3. 2026-2027 Budget Proposals: The selectmen discussed the current 2026-27 budget proposal. First Selectman Cahill proposed a new \$10,000 CNR budget for sanitation—transfer station since there were corrections required by the most recent OSHA report, a CNR account is a permanent account, and money will stay reserved for sanitation equipment and repair purposes. Mr. Cahill also continues to discuss curbside services for the town with the curbside contractor. Bulky waste will continue to be a separate consideration. The selectmen will continue to discuss budget proposals as they arrive.

4. Audience for Citizens: None

First Selectman Cahill moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:46 PM. Selectman Grindle seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
