

Hampton Board of Selectmen

The special meeting of the Hampton Board of Selectmen was called to order at 3:39 PM by First Selectman Allan Cahill. Also present were Selectmen Bob Grindle and John Tillinghast and Jennifer Nelson, Administrative Assistant.

2. Audience for Citizens: None
3. Dairy Abatements: The Woodmsansee Trust is now Grow Hill, LLC and the abatements are now Grow Hill, LLC and the Eva South Farm, LLC. After a brief discussion, **Selectman Bob Grindle moved to approve the dairy abatements of 25% for Grow Hill, LLC and Eva South Farm, LLC for the Grand List of 2025. Selectman John Tillinghast seconded the motion, and it carried with the following vote:**

4. Approval of Tax Collection Agreement: **Selectman Bob Grindle moved to empower First Selectman Allan Cahill to sign the Tax Collection Agreement with the Town of Canterbury. Selectman John Tillinghast seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.**
5. Approval of Little River Preserve Agricultural Agreement: First Selectman Cahill wished to table this agenda item. There is a researcher currently counting turtles, and Mr. Cahill wishes that work to be completed before any agreement is discussed. **Selectman Grindle moved to table this agenda item. First Selectman Allan Cahill seconded the motion, and the agenda item was unanimously tabled.**
6. Review 5-year Capital Improvement Plan: Selectmen discussed the current recommendations for the 5-year Capital Improvement Plan. **Selectman Bob Grindle moved to approve the 5-year plan, as written. Selectman John Tillinghast seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously**

**Selectman Bob Grindle moved to adjourn at 3:51 PM. First Selectman Cahill seconded the motion, and the meeting was adjourned.**
