Business Coordinator Report BOE Meeting June 23, 2021

Our Emergency and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER II) application has been approved in the amount of \$58,500 for school technology needs. The listing of approved technology is included as a separate attachment.

Administration continues to focus on plans for the American Rescue Plan Emergency and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ARP ESSER 3). As reported last month, we require public comment and input from families/legal guardians, administrators, teachers, school leaders, school staff, school unions, and stakeholders representing the interests of underserved students. A summary of our anticipated preschool funding and expenses for 2021-2022, as budgeted, is included as a separate attachment.

Our year to date Budget vs Actual through May 31, 2021 indicates several areas where funds will need to be transferred to/from and I anticipate requesting initial year end budget transfers at the July board of education meeting.

Our wellness webinar this month was Men's Health. The presentation focused on important health topics as they relate to men including nutrition, exercise, mental wellbeing, alcohol, testosterone levels and preventive care. It also discussed stereotypes regarding men's health and highlighted the top five health risks most commonly faced by men. This was the last webinar in our year-long focus on wellness sponsored by ConnectiCare.
