There was not a quorum, attendees reviewed the following convening at 7:03 pm.

Maryellen submitted the following written report on HES heat pumps

Regarding the heat pump project at the elementary school:

The Finance and Operations committee of the Board of Ed will be writing a Request for Proposals (a bid request) to heat, cool and ventilate the building as well as provide domestic hot water. We continue to look at the state's Department of Administrative Services competitive grant application requirements to meet them as we proceed in hopes that grants will be offered again in 2024. We continue to look at the cost of a 300 kW generator and oil tank removal. Action Air has worked with us and provided a proposal and equipment list. That will be set aside while we go out to bid. The Action Air proposal was submitted to the engineers at Eversource. They are backed up with work but will give us 2023 incentive funds rates. Our Eversource rep predicts that the 2024 incentives will be less generous. The BOE expects that whichever company it recommends for the project will present its proposal to the Board of Finance and the Board of Selectmen and then to a town meeting before a vote.
