Review of composting campaign and plans for mailing. The pamphlet, compost bin order form, and letter to residents are ready to go. (the mesh bottom will be added to the order form). We received the mailing list from the assessor's office. The mailing will go out during the first week of March. Envelopes with first class stamps will be ordered from USPS with return address and stamps. (We have around 160 already printed from our last mailing). Gulemo will print the three pieces and committee members will stuff the envelopes.

The composting sticker will be reviewed at next meeting. Hampton Elementary School received their composting books and kits paid for by the composting grant. They are grateful to the committee and have begun their units on composting. A workshop or composting presentation will be discussed at the next meeting. An incorrect grant budget was sent out with the agenda, the corrected budget is below.
