**Discuss and Set the Mill Rate for FY 2022-2023**: Chairman Donahue provided a worksheet that captured the most relevant numbers including Proposed Budget Total, Projected Revenues, Grand List Total, Collection Rate (97.5%), Adjusted Grand List, and a Mill Rate of 22.49 based on the Grand Levy / Adjusted Grand List. First Selectman Cahill expressed his frustration with the Solar park's unpaid liability of approximately \$300,000. Bob Grindle noted the reduction in last years mill rate of 1.28 mills.

**Motion:** Diane Gagnon, seconded by Judy Buell moved to set the mill rate at 22.49. The motion passed unanimously.

**Timetable for Collection of Taxes:** At Chairman Donahue's request, First Selectman Cahill confirmed that tax bills dated August 1<sup>st</sup> would be sent out to taxpayers with a due date of September 1<sup>st</sup>.
