

**TOWN OF HAMPTON**  
**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING – April 6, 2026**  
**MINUTES**

The Legal Voters and those qualified to vote in Town Meeting assembled in Town Meeting at the Hampton Town Hall, lower level, 164 Main Street Hampton, Connecticut on April 6, 2026, at 6:30 PM and transacted the following business:

1. Call to order: First Selectman Allan Cahill called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.
2. To elect a moderator for said meeting. Kathy Donahue moved/Bob Grindle seconded to elect Allan Cahill moderator. Allan Cahill was elected moderator unanimously by voice vote.
3. To hear discussion and act on the Interlocal Agreement by and between the Town of Hampton, the Town of Canterbury, and the Town of Scotland regarding Shared Revenue Collection Services.

First Selectman Allan Cahill detailed the steps that led to town management looking for a change from Windham revenue collection to the proposed Interlocal Agreement. Questions were asked by Dorothy Del Valle, Jessica Samios, and Kathi Newcombe regarding details of the Agreement and the associated three-year Regional Performance Incentive grant to be administered by the Northeastern CT Council of Governments. Mr. Cahill answered the questions to their satisfaction.

Canterbury First Selectman Christopher Lippke and Canterbury Tax Collector Natalie Ellston were in attendance and answered questions regarding Tax office administration and timing of program implementation.

Allan Cahill moved/Kathy Donahue seconded to approve the Interlocal Agreement by and between the Town of Hampton, the Town of Canterbury, and the Town of Scotland regarding Shared Revenue Collection Services. Motion carried by voice vote.

4. To transact any other business proper to come before the meeting. No further business was transacted.
5. Adjournment: Kathy Donahue moved/Bob Grindle seconded to adjourn at 6:52 PM.
