- 1. <u>Call to Order</u> Vice Chairman Gary DeCesare called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm.

- 3. Additions to Agenda None

- 5. Approval of Minutes: February 27, 2017 Everett Hyde moved to approve the February 27, 2017 minutes. Susan Hochstetter seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
- 6. Old Business
 - a. Plan of Conservation & Development Implementation Priorities John Guszkowski reviewed with the Commission what the top three priorities they indicated from the Implementation Matrix where, (1) Evaluate the areas surrounding the existing business zones to determine the potential for their expansion, (2) Enhance the appearance of the Business Zone on Route 6 and, (3) Evaluate the ability to utilize existing business zoned parcels for optimal economic development and revise zoning regulations as needed.
