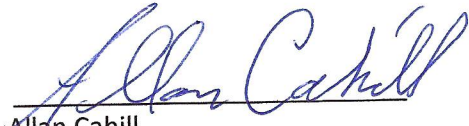
1. Call to order
2. To elect a moderator for said meeting.
3. To hear discussion and act on the Hampton Elementary School Budget for the year July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027 as recommended by the Board of Finance, and to appropriate sums of money as required.
4. To hear discussion and act on approving an additional appropriation of \$75,000 from the undesignated fund to complete the South Bigelow Rd. paving project.
5. To hear discussion and act on a proposal to hire an additional public works employee.
6. Adjournment

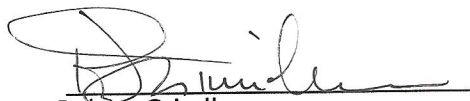
At its meeting held on September 8, 2026 the Board of Selectmen voted, pursuant to Section 7-7 of the Connecticut General Statutes, that items 3, 4, and 5 on the call of the September 17, 2026 Special Town Meeting be submitted to referendum vote on October 1, 2026 between the hours of Noon and 8:00 PM at the Town Hall, 164 Main Street, Hampton, CT.

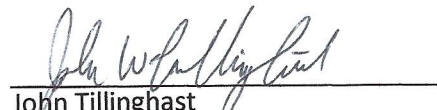
The designation of the questions on the ballot for said referendum vote shall be as follows:

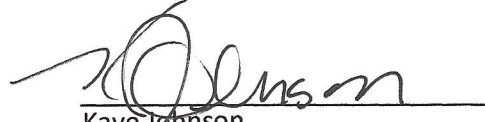
1. "Shall the Town of Hampton appropriate \$2,357,400 for the Hampton Elementary School for the 2026-2027 fiscal year?"
2. "Shall the Town of Hampton appropriate an additional \$75,000 from the undesignated fund to complete the South Bigelow Road paving project?"
3. "Shall the Town of Hampton approve the proposal to hire an additional public works employee at a cost of \$120,000?"
